General

- The Jingle Bell Jog starts and finishes at Waterend Barn, St Albans AL1 3LE
- All entry fees are non-refundable and non-transferrable.
- If you have registered for the Jingle Bell Jog (5km) or Fun Run (1.5km) and find that for any reason you are unable to take part please let us know as soon as possible. You must not give your place to anyone else and must return your sponsorship form.

Participant entry

- Anyone registering children under 18 must ensure they have parental consent for each child to participate.
- The Fun Run is open to adults and children of all ages and the Jingle Bell Jog is open to adults and children over 10 years old.

Health and safety

- If you are in doubt about your health or have a medical condition that could be affected by exercise, you should obtain your doctor's approval before participating in the Jingle Bell Jog or Fun Run.
